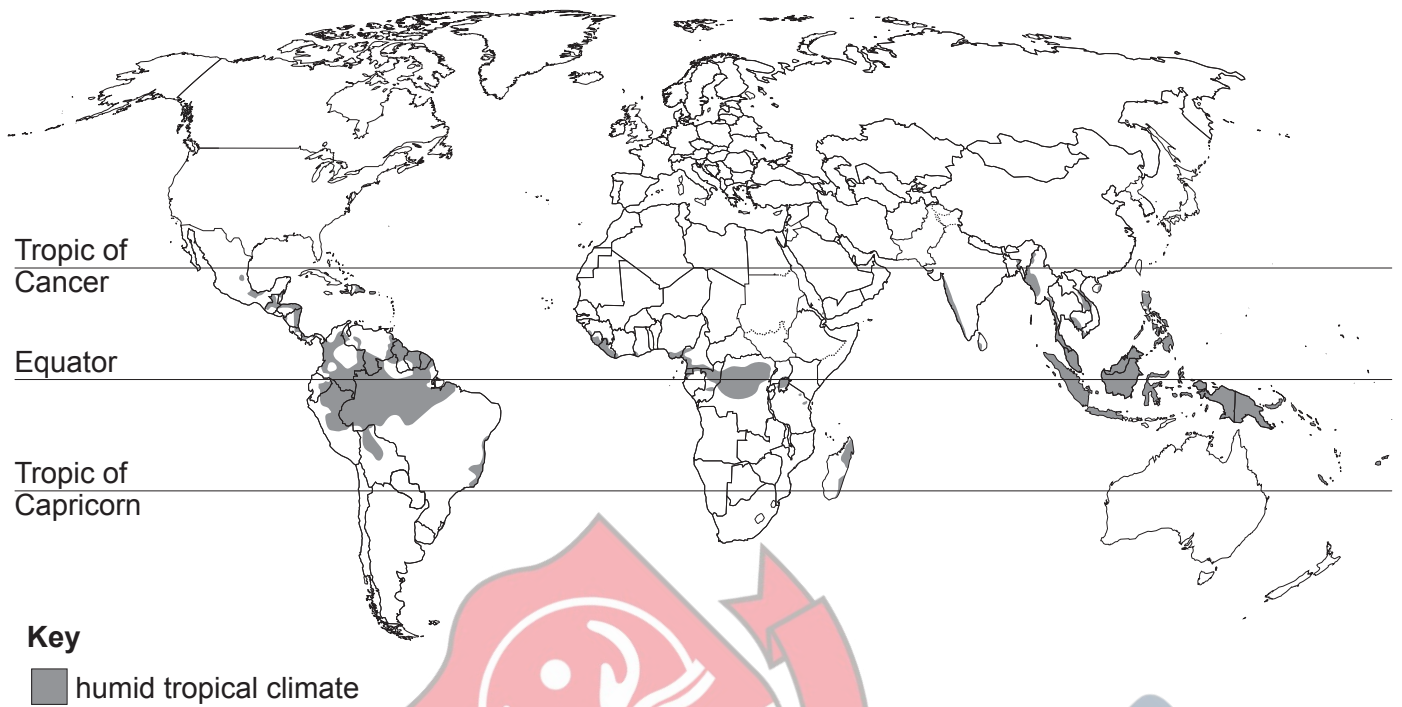

Coastal environment in Cantabria, Spain

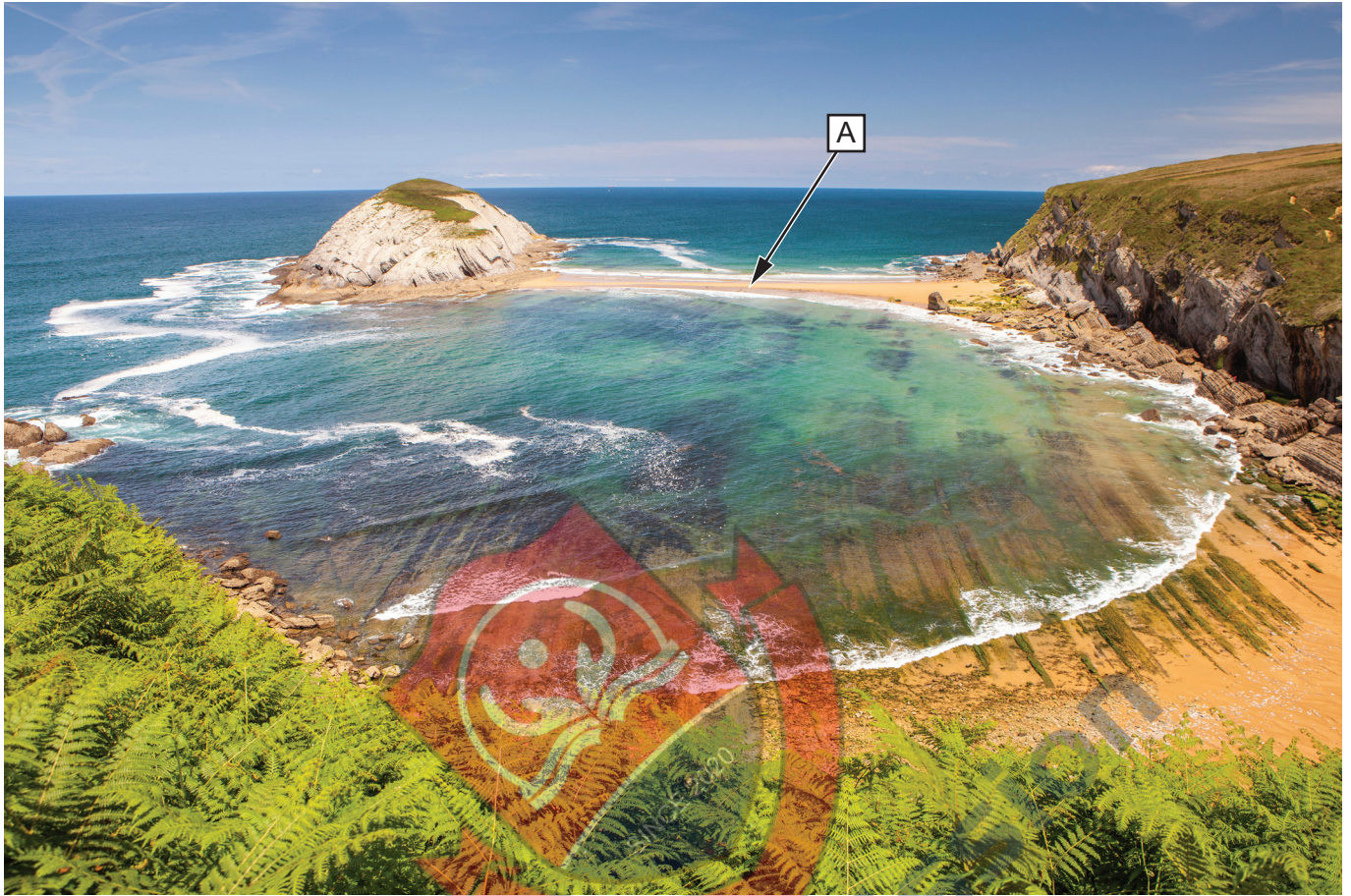

Predicted development of a tsunami after an earthquake in Japan, 11 March 2011

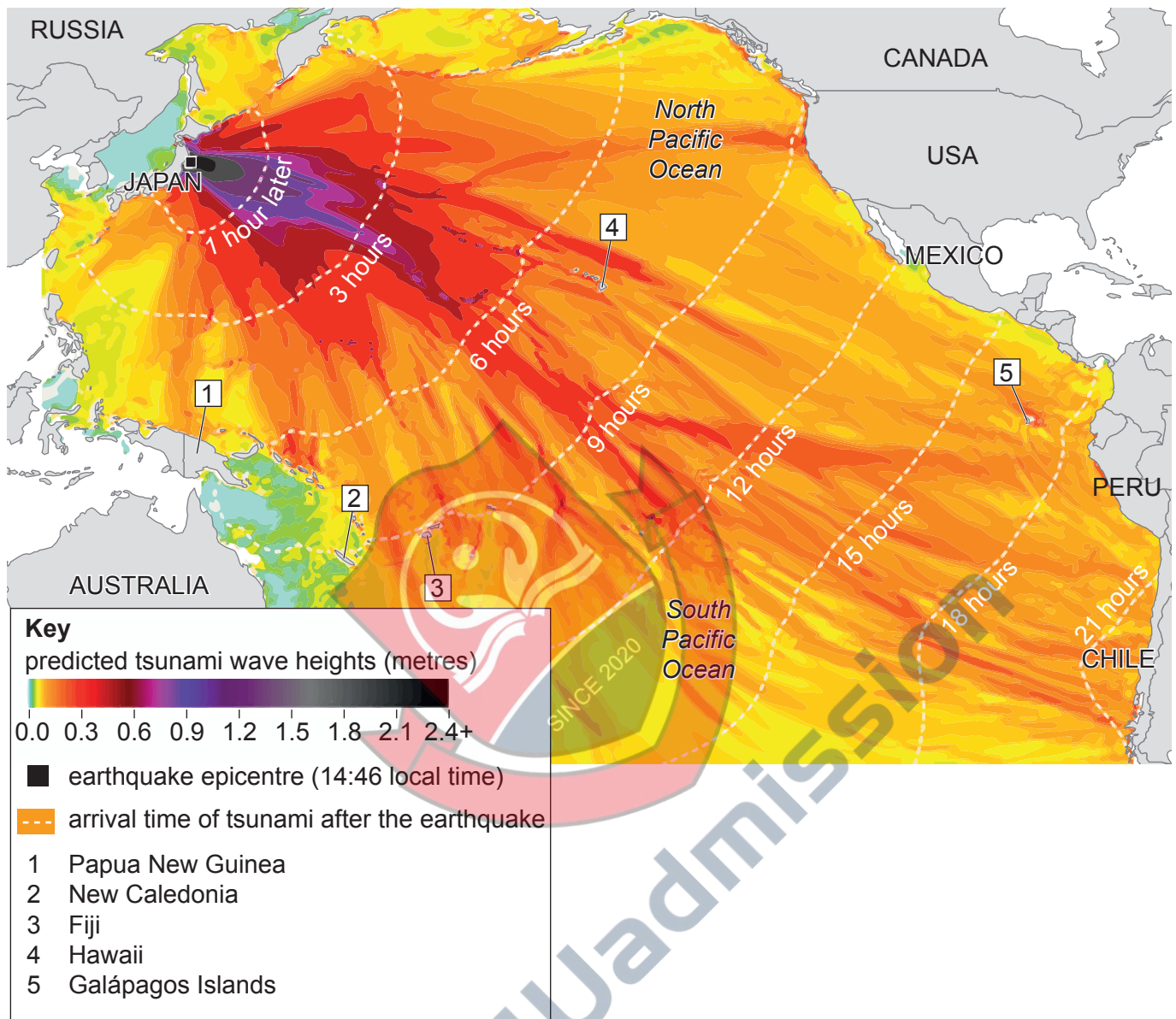
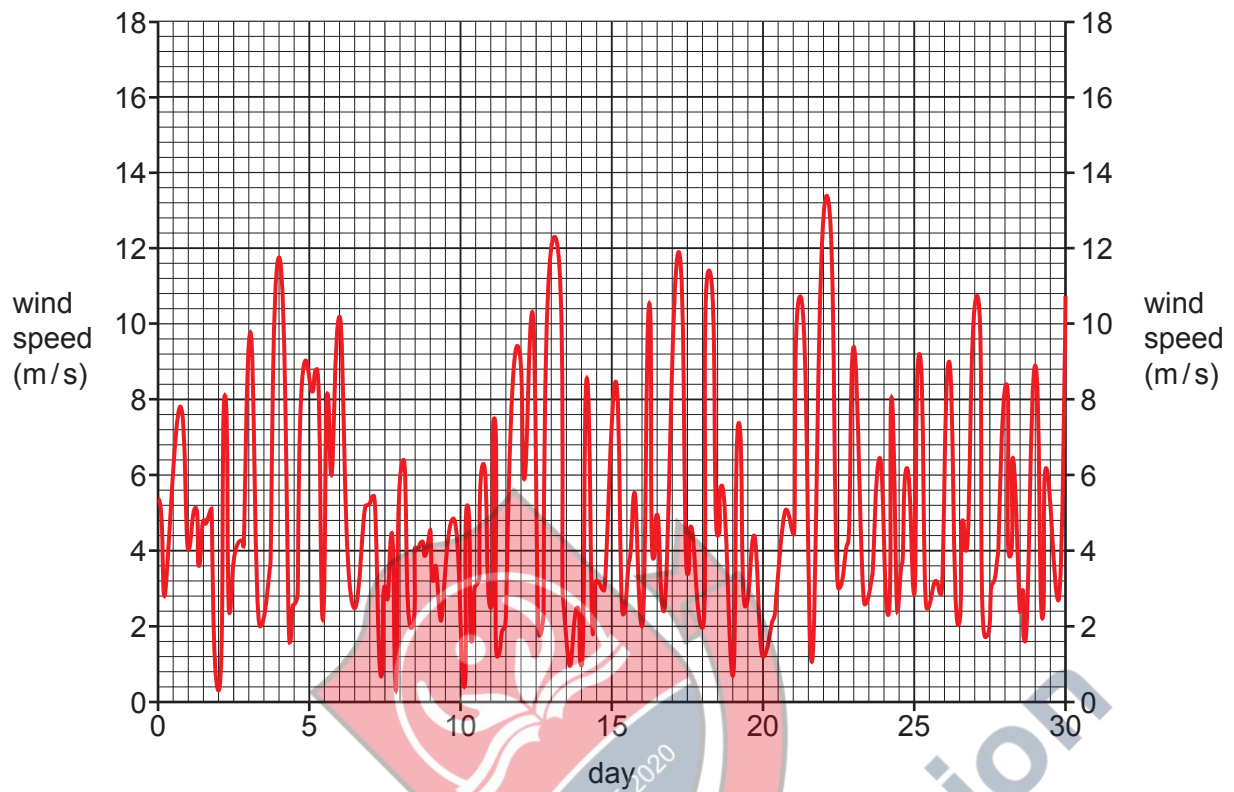
